

WORSHIP MINISTRY



EXTRAORDINARY MINISTER OF HOLY COMMUNION

A person who assists distributing Holy Communion at Mass and who may bring Communion to the home bound and sick. **The extraordinary minister must be approved by the pastor**, attend an Archdiocesan workshop and parish workshop. You must be a Catholic who is in good standing in the Catholic Church and regularly attends Mass on weekends and Holy Days of Obligation. **If married, you must be in a marriage recognized by the Catholic Church.** For more information contact Fr. LECTOR (READER)

A lector proclaims the Word of God during Mass or reads the intercessions. Lectors should have good diction, articulation, and reading skills. They devote time and preparation to understanding the Word of God so that all may hear and be open to God, transforming their lives. Lectors must be approved by the pastor attend an Archdiocesan workshop and become familiar with our procedures. You must be a Catholic who is in good standing in the Catholic Church and regularly attends Mass on weekends and Holy Days of Obligation. **If you married, you must be in a marriage recognized by the Catholic Church.** For more information contact Fr. USHERS

Facilitates order within the church. Ushers seat people for Mass, collect the offertory gifts, distribute materials that might be necessary for us at a particular celebration, help with the flow of Communion, distribute the bulletins as people leave Mass and count the number of people attending Mass.
